Member Syndicate Agreement

AFFILIATE AND PLAYER SYNDICATE AGREEMENT

This constitutes an Agreement between the Applicant or Member and Virtual World Direct Ltd. Registered Head Office: Virtual World Direct Ltd, Bourne Concourse, Peel Street, Ramsey, IM8 1JJ, Isle of Man. **Mailing Address:** Virtual World Direct Ltd, Member Support Centre, Commodore House, 51 Conway Road, Colwyn Bay, North Wales, LL29 7AW, United Kingdom.

1. A member is appointed as a Player Member from the date of acceptance of the application by the company. To apply for membership you must be 16 or over.

2. On approval of your application you will be sent an e-mail and an SMS (text message) which confirms your membership number and syndicate members.

3. A member must comply with the Policies and Procedures (available on the Virtual World Direct website) and with the terms of the 'Member Agreement', as and when amended by the company. A member acknowledges that he/she has a copy of the said agreement or has seen and has access to the same.

4. A member agrees to pay £5.00 per week (per syndicate placement) for the e-Lottery membership subscription. A member understands that if the subscription payment is not received by the company on the due date they will be removed from their syndicate and will no longer be entitled to any winnings generated by said syndicate. They will be notified of this by e-mail and / or SMS message (if we have their mobile phone details). All credit/debit card transactions, both successful and unsuccessful, are recorded by ourselves and by our Merchant bank. If a member is removed from a syndicate for Payment Failure or Cancellation and the said syndicate consequently wins, VWD are not liable to pay any winnings to said member. Subscription payments are ongoing until cancelled in accordance with clause 6.

5. UK syndicate winnings are equally divided among the 49 syndicate members. Each player will receive 1/49th of the total amount of winnings due. Euro syndicate winnings are divided among the 39 syndicate members. Each player will receive 1/39th of the total amount of winnings due. Virtual World Direct guarantees to pay all winnings due subject to these winnings being paid to Virtual World Direct by the Lottery operator. Winnings paid above ten pounds (£10.00 GBP) are issued in full. Should you request a winnings payout for less than ten pounds (£10.00 GBP) a two pound and fifty pence (£2.50) administration fee will apply.

6. A member may cancel this agreement at any time by giving 48 hours written notice to the company. Membership is deemed cancelled when the company has acknowledged the cancellation request.

7. The company may terminate this agreement by giving notice in writing if a member's conduct in any way compromises the company's reputation or contravenes the Policies and Procedures or the Member Syndicate agreement. A member has 30 days in which to appeal against the decision, with legal representation if required.

8. If any provision in the membership agreement is found to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable the company may amend or delete the provision. The amendment or deletion of any clause will not affect the remaining clauses and provisions.

9. The company never forfeits its rights to require a member's compliance with the membership agreement or with applicable laws and regulations governing business conduct. Only in rare circumstances will a policy be waived, which is only permitted when conveyed in writing by the company. Any such waiver will apply only in that specific case and may not be used as a precedent in any other case.

10. The company's failure to exercise any of the rights in this agreement or to insist on strict compliance with the Policies and Procedures does not constitute a waiver of the company's right to require compliance. Waiver of any part of this agreement or any provision of the rewards programme must be in writing and signed by an authorised officer of the company.

11. This agreement is subject to acceptance by the company at its Support Centre. Acceptance shall be deemed to occur when the company sends a letter or electronic mail of acceptance and/or a copy of this agreement, duly signed by an authorised officer of the company.

12. Virtual World Direct is the syndicate manager and as such purchases all lottery tickets in its name. Virtual World Direct does not purchase lottery tickets in your name or on your behalf. As an e-Lottery subscriber you do not acquire any interest in any Lottery tickets. Virtual World Direct does not sell lottery tickets to members and does not operate a lottery.

13. I understand that the weekly charge is to cover the subscription which includes news bulletins and the benefits of the e-Lottery system, as set out in this document and not for the purchase of lottery tickets

THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS APPLY TO AFFILIATE MEMBERS :

14. An Affiliate member is appointed as an independent Affiliate member for one (1) calendar year from the date of acceptance of the application by the company. To apply for an Affiliate membership you must be 18 or over.

15. At the end of each calendar year the company will debit the affiliate member's account for the amount of the annual renewal fee, currently four pounds and ninety nine pence (£4.99) unless the member terminates the agreement in accordance with clause 6 prior to the anniversary date.

16. An affiliate member is authorised to invite and take (but not accept) applications for the e-Lottery system at the retail prices specified by the company, but is under no obligation to do so. The company reserves the right to accept or reject any membership applications for any reason, in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the company's Policies and Procedures, which are subject to amendment.

17. The company will pay to an affiliate member commissions and other benefits as set out in the company's Affiliate Rewards Programme, which may be updated periodically, on all e-Lottery subscriptions accepted from an affiliate member. Commissions will be paid on a predetermined date (which is subject to change). The company reserves the right to recover any commissions paid on subscriptions which are being refunded, as well as any commissions paid in error.

18. If an affiliate member wishes to promote Virtual World Direct and the e-Lottery system he/she is an independent operator in business on their own. An affiliate member is not under any obligation to undertake any work of any nature whatsoever. The company shall not be responsible for any sick leave, taxes or similar matters and accepts no responsibility for the procuring of insurance or any superannuation in respect of the operations of an affiliate member.

19. An affiliate member will bear all costs and expenses incurred by him/her in connection with their activities as an affiliate member, and he/she hereby indemnifies and keeps the company indemnified against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages, costs, and expenses arising out of or in any way relating to their actions. The company is responsible only for the inherent quality and integrity of its products and services.

20. Commission is calculated at the end of every four-week business cycle. A playing period is also over four weeks which begins from the date the application is approved and every four weeks thereafter.

21. An affiliate member can introduce another affiliate member anywhere in the world. However, there are many countries and it is impossible to know the laws of all of them. It is the introduced affiliate member's responsibility to ensure they obey the laws of their country.

22. Any sale or assignment of the membership must be approved in writing by the company. Successors in interest or assigns must comply with all provisions of this agreement.
